

School Health Advisory Committee (SHAC) Report

The SHAC Committee met four times this year and reviewed our existing Wellness policy and made appropriate changes to comply with the July 2014 statutory requirements for implementation and the Federal Smart Snack rules as advised by TASB Policy Service.

Our draft was sent to TASB and returned with recommendations and the clean draft was accepted by the SHAC committee March 7, 2016. The River Road School Board of Trustees approved the policy at the April Board Meeting.

Campus Improvement Plans showed that sites were following the Wellness Policy. We need to purchase new Catch Kits with updated material. Nutrition information was posted on the Food Service webpage monthly and Nutrition Newsletters were sent home to Elementary families and posted on all site Facebook pages. The October Health Fair was a great success. We had support from many local vendors and had over a thousand people in attendance. Rolling Hills and Willow Vista both held their annual track meets in May.
