

Walk-In Immunization Clinics: Potter and Randall Counties

- Take a current shot record to all locations.
- Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- Call ahead to ensure location has supply of vaccine needed.
- Age restrictions may apply at some locations.
- Clinics charge for private vaccine, some clinics are able to bill insurance.
- Each family must know their insurance benefits prior to visiting the clinic.
- This is not an all inclusive list; please contact any pharmacy or your doctor's office.

Extended hours: 1st Tuesday of each month 1-6 p.m.

Cost: \$5 for one shot, \$10 for two or more. No eligible patient will be turned away due to inability to pay.

Children: Medicaid or No insurance

Adults: No insurance

All patients must bring a current shot record. No private insurance accepted.
